

# Corrections & Additions to The French Image of America

### Introduction

This list is meant to update and provide corrections to:

Durand Echeverria & Everett C. Wilkie, Jr. The French Image of America: A Chronological and Subject Bibliography of French Books Printed before 1816 relating to the British North American Colonies and the United States. 2 vols. Metuchen: Scarecrow, 1994. (ISBN 0-8108-2837-5)

The work sought to discover and describe several categories of publications, principally any French publication or publication in the French language printed before 1816 that concerned the British North American colonies, including those in the West Indies, and later the United States. Other categories of materials, such as those by Americans published in France, were also included. The work was the result of nearly forty years of combined research by the authors.

In addition to editorial corrections (e.g., typos), other additions are welcome. Among those are confirmed added locations for listed materials; other editions, issues, or variants of listed publications; and previously undescribed works that fall within the bibliography's scope (e.g., 781/45A below). At the time the bibliography was compiled, locating copies depended, of course, on such print sources at NUC Pre-56, the British Museum printed catalogue, the Bibliothèque Nationale printed catalogue, etc. Added locations are a sticking point, however, because many of the included works are quite common. Those based merely upon OCLC listings are not invited. As useful as OCLC is for certain purposes, that bibliographical utility is not trustworthy for this type of revision in and of itself. Any supposed copy would have to be confirmed by actual examination. Locations added by the EngSTC are also not invited. That database was checked during the compilation of the work, and although more copies have probably surfaced since that time, which was almost twenty years ago, unless something dramatically new has been reported, it is assumed that the database has been checked. The original publication made no pretense of locating every known copy of a work, but added confirmed locations of extremely rare materials would be welcome (e.g., 792/42, where the only known copy finally surfaced, and 798/62, which adds the only copy known in a United States library).

The revisions are done in the same style as the original publication, which is long out of print.

I am especially grateful to Steve Ferguson of Princeton University, Susan Newberry of the John Carter Brown Library, and Elaine Shiner of Harvard University for supplying me with numerous valuable corrections and additions.
